I am writing in response to your letter dated December 13, 2006 regarding the 21st Century Majority Fund's 12 Day Pre-General Report (10/01/2006-10/18/2006).

The \$5000 contribution on 8/7/06 to Bob Corker for Senate was disclosed as a contribution for General 2006 and it should have been designated to the Primary 2006. The September Monthly report has been amended to reflect this change and a copy of the letter to the Corker campaign is below.

This is also a response to your inquiry regarding "Fundraising Consulting" and "Golf Fundraiser." The fundraising consulting disbursement was paid to Campaign Consulting Group, which is the consulting group that plans events to benefit the 21st Century Majority Fund and was not made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates. The expenditures made for "Golf Expenses-Fundraiser" and "Golf Fundraiser" were expenses from a fundraiser to benefit the 21st Century Majority Fund and were not made on behalf of specifically identified federal candidates. The disbursements were for expenses accrued during the golf event which benefited the 21st Century Majority Fund.
