This letter is in response to your request for additional information, dated July 7, 2011.

1. The vendor refund from Greene's is now reported as a negative disbursement on Schedule H4 and the nonfederal amount has been netted out of the Committee's transfer from nonfederal made in August 2011. The above report has been amended to reflect this correction and subsequent reports are being amended to correct the column B year to date information.
2. All disbursements for Health Insurance have been moved to line 31(b) and are now reported as FEA. Any amounts transferred from nonfederal for the previously allocated portion will be netted out of the transfer from nonfederal made in August 2011. The above report has been amended to reflect this correction and subsequent reports are being amended to correct the column B year to date information.
3. All payments disclosed on Schedule H4 for 'Party Media Service' have been changed to 'Party Web Services' to more accurately describe their purpose. These were not expenditures for any type of public communication related to candidates for Federal Office. Please note that the Committee used this description for all of 2010 and never received a question from the FEC related to it. The above report has been amended to reflect these changes.
4. The Committee has answered this inquiry several times throughout 2010. Payments for Party Fundraising disclosed on Schedule H4 are NOT related to any specific event or program. This individual is a consultant for fundraising to the party and consulting payments are administrative payments and accurately disclosed on Schedule H4.
