Dear Mr. Clinesmith:

Congratulations to you on the extraordinary effort you mounted in your campaign for the House of Representatives last year. We heard very positive things about your operation and I know that Congressman Rangel was disappointed that the outcome was not what you had hoped for.

The Federal Election Commission has contacted us concerning our reporting of contributions from the National Leadership PAC to your campaign. Because of an error in our records, we reported the following contributions to your committee:

June 29, 2000	\$1000 for your primary
August 22, 2000	\$4000 for your general election
October 10, 2000	\$2000 for your general election

Our intention with the October 22 contribution, as we noted on the memo line of the check, was to make it for your primary debt. However, because of an error in our database we inadvertently reported to the FEC as a contribution to your general election — bringing us over the \$5000 per election limit.

The FEC has asked that you refund \$1000 to the National Leadership PAC. An envelope is enclosed for your convenience.
