This letter is in response to your letter to us dated July 3, 2001, that was prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the above referenced report.

Per our telephone conversation, dated August 1, 2001, we have concluded that the error in the amended report was due to a matter of miscommunication between the FEC, our Political Action Committee here at Mass Mutual and our software company, GNOSSOS Software. GNOSSOS Software apparently filed an incorrect *electronic* amendment on May 8, 2001 for the report referenced above *after* a corrected paper copy was already filed and mailed directly to you on April 11, 2001.


