Dear Mr. Dickinson:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Line 11a)(i) of the Detailed Summary Page of your report discloses a total of \$230,763 in itemized contributions from individuals. The sum of the entries itemized on Schedule A, however, indicates the total to be \$245,658. Please amend your report to clarify the discrepancy.

-Your report discloses the receipt of \$36,930 in "voided checks" on Schedule A supporting Line 15 of the Detailed Summary Page. If a check written by your committee was not cashed, you should itemize the voided check on Schedule B as a negative entry supporting the line of the Detailed Summary Page where the disbursement was originally disclosed. Line 15 should be used for offsets to operating expenditures in the form of refunds or rebates. Please amend your report to correct this discrepancy or provide clarification regarding this transaction.

A written response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. If you need assistance, please feel free to contact me on our
