Dear Mr. Dodson:

I am writing in reference to the letters submitted to Mr. John Antoline, the Treasurer for the Beaver County Democratic Party Committee. I would like to clarify the issues that you have raised within your letter concerning the July Quarterly Report (04/04/98 - 06/30/98).

As I had explained to you on the telephone the Democratic Party of Beaver County does not have a headquarters or individuals that are employed by the organization. We operate with volunteers at election time.


We maintain two separate accounts, one that is for federal candidates and the other for all other candidates. Election materials for the candidates are maintained separately and there is not any commingling of funds.

The explanation used on Schedule B of this reporting period under the purpose of disbursement was incorrect. The expenses that were incurred were for individuals to work the various polling places within each of the voting districts.

The \$500.00 deposit shown on Schedule A of this same reporting period was not a contribution to this account but a correction made for an erroneous deposit. The deposit should have been made into the Beaver County Democratic Party's account which is used for the elections and contributions to the Committee by those candidates who are not federal candidates. It was erroneously deposited into the Federal Election Account.

I hope that these explanations rectify the problems that you had cited in the report. Thank you for your assistance over the telephone and these corrections are what we had discussed.

Dear Mr. Dodson:


Per our recent telephone conversation I am responding in writing to the problems which you have cited in your letter to the Treasurer of the Beaver County Democratic Party Committee for the reporting period of 10/01/98 - 11/23/98.

The first question that you raise in this report is in excessive contribution received from a federal candidate. Please note that this contribution is not a donation to the committee. These monies were for vendor payments for the election. I believe per our telephone conversation that you had stated this would be permissible and that there would be no further need to amend this report if we had stated in writing to you what the purpose of money received was utilized for during this period.

I would like to also state to you as in our telephone conversation that we do not have any administrative expenses for the Beaver County Democratic Party. We do not employ people or operate a headquarters. We rely on volunteers.

I hope that this clarifies the reporting problems that you had cited in your letter. Thank you for your assistance and consideration.
