This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 item(s):

1. Your committee failed to designate a campaign depository on Line 9. Please be advised that each registered political committee must designate a campaign depository or depositories. The committee must maintain at least one checking account or transaction account at one of the depositories. Please amend your Statement of Organization (FEC Form 1) to disclose the committee's depository. (11 CFR § 102.2(a)(1)(vi) and 11 CFR §103.2)
2. Your Statement of Organization (FEC Form 1) does not include an email address for your committee. As of January 1, 2007, the Federal Election Commission began sending all courtesy mailings exclusively by electronic mail. Reporting reminders and mailings concerning changes in the law are no longer sent to committees by U.S. mail. In addition, mandatory electronic filers are required to provide an electronic mail address, if such an address exists. (11 CFR §102.2(a)(1)(vii)) Please amend your Statement of Organization to disclose a current email address.

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will**
