This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Your report includes a Schedule H1 with section A (*Fixed Federal Percentage for National Party Committees*) checked. However, separate segregated funds that allocate should use section C (*Funds Expended for Separate Segregated Funds and Non-Connected Committees*). Further, Schedule H1 is used by committees that have established separate federal and non-federal accounts to allocate between its federal account and non-federal account all administrative expenses and generic voter drive costs 11 CFR §106.6. If your committee does not maintain a separate non-federal account, then Schedule H1 does not need to be filed. Please amend your report with clarifying information.

Any amendment or clarification should be filed with the Federal Election Commission. Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations, and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
