Request for additional information:

An amendment for most of the inquiries was filed 7/9/04, FEC-125019.

Additional text response follows:

Inquiry: Commission Regulations require than a committee disclose the identification of all individuals who contribute in excess of \$200 in a calendar year...

Response: the Democratic Party of Wisconsin (DPW) in it's original solicitations, does include a clear and conspicuous request for the contributor information and informs the contributor of the requirements of federal law for the reporting of such information.

In order to comply with the formal requirements for "best efforts", the DPW:

1. Clearly asks for the missing information, without soliciting a contribution
2. Informs the contributor of the requirements of federal law for the reporting of such information, and
3. When the request is written, includes a pre-addressed return envelope

Additionally, the DPW has a policy of 1) telephone contact followed by 2) a written request for information, including a pre-addressed return envelope on a two week cycle, every two weeks, for all contribution records lacking full identification, including full name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer.
