

This Form 99 Miscellaneous Report is being filed in response to the April 12, 2011 letter from the FEC concerning America's Health Insurance Plans PAC's (the PAC) Year-End Report (11/23/2010-12/31/2010). Specifically, the letter notes that the ending balance of the 30 Day Post-General Report does not match the beginning balance of the Year-End Report and that the Column B figures of the Year-End Report do not match the sum of the Column A figures of the Year-End Report and Column B figures from the 30 Day Post-General Report. Please be advised that an amendment is being filed to the PAC's 30 Day Post-General Report and the ending balance of the PACs amended 30 Day Post-General Report matches the beginning balance of the PAC's Year-End Report. Moreover, the Calendar Year-to-Date totals in Column B on the PAC's Year-End Report are now correct when calculated by adding the Calendar Year-to-Date totals in Column B on the PAC's amended 30 Day Post-General Report and the Total This Period amounts in Column A of the PAC's Year-End Report. America's Health Insurance Plans ("AHIP") originally learned of the discrepancy noted in the FEC's letter when the PAC's Year-End Report was prepared. AHIP utilizes a vendor to prepare and file FEC reports via an online software system. While the PAC's amended 30 Day Post-General Report was originally prepared and approved by AHIP for submission to the FEC prior to when the PAC's Year-End Report was due, the amendment was never sent via the electronic process due to an administrative oversight. We discovered this oversight upon receipt of the FEC's correspondence and are filing the PAC's amended 30 Day Post-General Report.
