
Dear Julie,

Enclosed is a copy of the letter that Tyson Foods, Inc. Political Action Committee (TYPAC) sent to the "Tim Hutchinson For Senate" campaign requesting a refund of \$2000 (the amount in excess of the \$5000 per election limit). This is in response to your letter dated July 3, 2002. Per your and my conversation, I sent this letter requesting the refund in order to correct the incorrect contribution and to comply with Federal Election campaign requirements. I believe that this should correct the mistake for the excess contribution.

In addition, your letter also addressed three contributions earlier this year where the designation for the election was incorrect. On all three contributions (Dooley, Bonilla, and Combest), the designation on our FEC filing reports was for the Primary Elections when in fact, they should have been for the General Elections. I have filed amendments to the original and any subsequent reports in order to make the necessary corrections.

I believe that the above should correct any and all errors. However, if there is anything else that I have not addressed, please let me know. Again, thank you for bringing these errors to my attention so that I could correct them.

Re: Excess Contribution


Dear Mr. Stuart

It has been brought to our attention by the Federal Election Commission, that TYPAC inadvertently made a contribution to the "Tim Hutchinson For Senate Campaign" which caused it to exceed the legal limit of \$5000 per election cycle.

In reviewing our records, it was discovered that TYPAC made two contributions of \$1000 apiece designated to the general election early in the election cycle (\$1000 in December 1998 and \$1000 in December 1999). TYPAC then made a contribution of \$5000 designated to the General election campaign of Senator Hutchinson in April of 2002 year unaware of the previous contribution. This contribution caused TYPAC to exceed the allowed contribution limit for the 2002 General Election by \$2000.

As required by the FEC, we are requesting that the excess contribution of \$2000 be refunded as soon as possible to "TYPAC" in order to comply with Federal Campaign requirements. We apologize for the oversight and regret any inconvenience this may have caused. Thank you for your understanding.
