
Dear Mr. Gibson:

I am in receipt of your letter dated April 10, 2003 notifying me that the Freedom Project had not responded to Antoinette Kitchen's letter of March 19, 2003. Upon receipt of this letter, Ms. Kitchen was notified that The Freedom Project did not receive the March 19 letter and would respond by the April 30 deadline set in your letter.

The March 19 letter indicates that The Freedom Project may have made excessive contributions to several candidates and that it must seek a refund of the excessive amount of any contribution, or provide a written authorization for a redesignation. The Freedom Project had requested refunds from each of the candidates identified in your letter on October 20, 2002. Copies of those letters will be included in hard copy of this letter filed with the Federal Election Commission.
