This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Please provide a Schedule A to support the entry on Line 12 of the Detailed Summary Page. All transfers from affiliates received by your committee must be itemized on Schedule A regardless of the amount. 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(3)(D)

-There should not be a gap in the coverage dates for your reports. An amended Mid-Year Report is necessary to disclose the activity from 5/16/95 through 6/30/95.

-Line 6(a) of the Summary Page represents the total cash-on-hand as of January 1, 1995 or the date the group or organization became a political committee. This figure should be the same on all the reports covering the calendar year. Please amend your report to clarify the change made in Line 6(a).

-For present and future amendments, please note that your committee need only submit a Summary Page, Detailed Summary Page, corrected or omitted Schedules, and if desired, a cover letter explaining any changes or corrections made. Schedules that have previously been submitted and do not require changes or clarifications do not need to be resubmitted.
