
Redesignations should be made within sixty days of the original contribution and reported as memo entries on Schedule B, supporting Line 23, of the report covering the period during which redesignation is made. Please amend the appropriate report(s) accordingly.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
