Re: American Mid-Sized Banks (AMSB) PAC's Reply to the Commission's Request for Additional Information

Dear Ms. Miller:

This submission is in response to the Commission's Request for Additional Information dated December 19, 2013. Additionally, our committee has submitted a copy of this correspondence electronically via the FECFile software.

- 1. A clerical error resulted in the misreporting of the \$2,000 contribution originally attributed to the Wisconsin Bankers Association "WISCBANKPAC"). This contribution was an individual contribution from Philip Flynn, President and CEO of Associated Bank. The funds were released through the Alliance of Bankers for Wisconsin's (ABW) Conduit Fund. In transferring these funds to our committee, the ABW Conduit Fund acted as "conduit" of "directed" individual funds to candidates or committees under Section 11.06(11) of the Wisconsin Statutes and other provisions of laws governing conduit funds. This contribution was also transferred by the conduit in accordance with the laws and regulations for collected agents, 11 C.F.R. § 102.6(c), and within the specified time period after the request for transfer was made (see Federal Election Commission Advisory Opinion, No. 1996-18 (June 14, 1996)). A copy of the cover letter accompanying this contribution is attached (Attachment #1). We have amended the 2013 Mid-Year Report to properly report this contribution as an individual contribution.
- 2. Our Committee has requested in writing and received confirmation that the Jeff Merkley for Oregon committee will re-designate \$2,400 of the \$5,000 contribution made on June 13, 2013. Therefore, \$2,000 of this contribution will be designated to the 2014 primary election and the remaining \$2,400 of the contribution will be designated to the 2014 general election. A copy of the re-designation request and the response from Jeff Merkley for Oregon are attached (Attachment #2). We will disclose the re-designation as a memo entry on Schedule B supporting Line 23 of the report covering this month to properly report this contribution.




