This letter is in response to your letter dated August 30, 2000 concerning questions raised concerning certain information contained in the above referenced report.

Reporting only the name of the connected organization, abbreviating the name of the committee so it is unrecognizable, or using an indistinguishable acronym is inadequate. The following committee names from your report need further clarification: CPC-PAC, ASAPAC, AGSHF, CP&L, CTIA PAC, and NACSPAC. Please amend your report to include the missing information. 11 CFR §§ 100.12, 102.14(e) and 104.3(a)(4)(ii).


