

This letter is in response to your letter dated May 27, 2010. The following is our ""best efforts"" procedure:

First, in our original solicitation, we clearly and conspicuously request the contributors information and inform the contributor of the requirements of federal law for the reporting of such information.

Second, if the information is not provided, we make a follow-up, stand alone effort to obtain the missing information, regardless of whether the contribution was solicited or not. We do this no later than 30 days after receipt of the contribution and is sent in the form of a request via mail, e-mail or telephone documented in writing. Follow-up requests are done when necessary. We clearly ask for the missing information, without soliciting a new contribution. We inform the contributor of the requirements of federal law for the reporting of such information and if in writing, include a pre-addressed post card or return envelope.

Finally, if we receive contributor information after the contributor has been reported, we either file with our next regularly scheduled report, an amended memo Schedule A listing all the contributions for which additional information was received or we file on or before our next regularly scheduled reporting date, amendments to the report(s) originally disclosing the contributions.
