Mr. Gibson:

Today, I received your letter dated April 6, 1995 (copy attached). This letter is to inform you that Florida BankPac has responded to all of the FEC's requests of March 15, for additional information on the referenced reports with the exception of the July Monthly report. Florida BankPac responded to your requests by certified mail on March 28. Certified mail receipt P230-452-058 included responses from Florida BankPac regarding Amcnded August Monthly, September Monthly, October Monthly and 12 Day Pre-General reports. This material was received by the Federal Election Commission as indicated from the postal receipt.

In response to the 30 Day Post-General, Florida BankPac replied via certified mail on April 11, 1995, receipt P230-452-061. Obviously, the FEC did not receive this material prior to your letter of April 6 and Florida BankPac has yet to receive confirmation from the postal service.

The remaining report, July Monthly, dealing with a PAC contribution from First Union Employees Committee of Continuous Existence is being reviewed. However, based on my initial examination of records, it appears this contribution was inadvertently deposited in Florida BankPac's federal account and should have been deposited in the state account. Florida BankPac is taking the necessary steps to correct this mistake.

Florida BankPac makes every effort to comply within the guidelines of the law and apologizes for any inconvenience these reporting oversights may have caused.
