This is in response to your August 29, 1996, memo to J. Mark Leggett as treasurer of the NationsBank Corporation PAC (ID # C00043489).


The reference item was the June Monthly Report (5/1/96 - 6/31/96).

This is in response to your August 7, 1996, memo to J. Mark Leggett as treasurer of the NationsBank Corporation PAC (ID # C00049489).

The reference item was the June Monthly Report (5/1/96 - 5/31/96). There are two items for review.

The first item was a question on candidate limit of \$5,000 per election.


Our records for the candidate entry in question show that the 1991 payment was for debt retirement to the prior cycle campaign. We incorrectly listed as a 'General' instead of 'Debt Retirement'. Attached is an amended report for the 1991 listing.

The second item was a question on calendar year limit to a national political party (The Republican House-Senate Dinner Trust).

This is similar to a question raised last year. Our information from the organization advises that the contribution to the "Trust" is for non-federal purposes (attached is a copy of the Contribution Guidelines from the organization). It is our understanding that contributions to the "Trust" are separate from a limit test standpoint to the respective party committees. Please advise if this is not the case.
