Dear Ms. Manzano:

This letter is in response to your correspondence of March 12 requesting additional information about our 30-Day Post Election report.

The contribution in question, to Carolyn McCarthy for Congress, was incorrectly disclosed as a result of a clerical error. HRC PAC's \$2,500 contribution to Carolyn McCarthy for Congress, made on 8/8/96, was for the primary election and should have been designated as such. We have already made this correction on our amended FEC report filed on March 21.

In addition, you requested additional information concerning the total for line 6(d), column B of the 30-Day Post Election report summary page. A clerical error was made when filing this report which resulted in the omission of a total for Line 6(d), column B. We have already made this correction on our amended FEC report filed on March 21.

Also, you requested additional information about a \$1,000 contribution to the South Dakota Coordinated Campaign, which we made on 10/25/96, and which was reported on the 30-Day Post Election report. We listed this contribution on our Schedule B form using the best information available to us at the time. We have since discovered the correct name for the "South Dakota Coordinated Campaign" is "South Dakota Democratic Party" and we have already made this correction on our amended FEC report.

Finally, you requested additional information about the 24-hour reporting for expenditures in North Carolina. In an attempt to provide the most complete picture of the PAC's activities in North Carolina, HRC PAC chose to report all expenses associated with these efforts, including general office expenses, local and long-distance phone service, fax, overnight mail, and rent. These disbursements do not meet the definition of "independent expenditures" which include only expenditures for communications expressly advocating the election or defeat of a candidate.


