Your October 20, 2000 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-In your response you indicate that you will file an amendment adjusting the beginning cash balance of the above-referenced report to equal the ending balance of your June Monthly Report as soon as you receive instructions from the Commission regarding how to do so electronically.

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by November 15, 2000. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
