Dear Mr. Buckley:

In response to the above referenced letters seeking clarification:

All "Payroll", "Payroll Taxes", "AFLAC Payroll", "Payroll Re-Issue", "Payroll Pd to Seligman", "Health Insurance", and "Supplemental Insurance" disclosed on Schedule H4 are for employees who did NOT spend more than 25% of their compensated time in a given month on Federal Election Activity (FEA) or activities in connection with a Federal election.

The receipt of \$105,000.34 disclosed on Schedule A supporting Line 17 reflected the receipt of tax check-off funds.

The disbursement of payment(s) for "Booth Rental" was a non-public communication, generic disbursement and was, therefore, disclosed and reported correctly.

The disbursement of payment(s) for "Printing" was for a general party fundraising event (raising Federal funds) not on behalf of a specific federal candidate and was, therefore, disclosed and reported correctly.
