James Hooff contributed \$4,600 to the Committee, and the excessive portion has been redesignated to the general election. Please note that his contribution record has been changed to James Campbell to list his name correctly.

The full amount of Evoydeene Bailey s contribution to the Committee was inadvertently attributed to the general election. This error has been corrected and the amendment now reflects a maximum contribution to the primary and to the general elections.

The Committee incorrectly attributed two contributions to the partnership of Ropes & Gray, rather than to Thomas and

Regina Pyle as individuals. This error has been corrected on the amendment filed today, and the excessive portions of their contributions have been redesignated to the general election or refunded.

The Committee incorrectly attributed a \$4,600 check from the partnership Sokol, Behot & Fiorenzo to Neil Yoskin, as an individual contribution from Neil Yoskin. This error has been corrected in the amendment filed today. This partnership contribution has been attributed to two partners in the following manner: Neil Yoskin, \$1,150 to the primary and \$1,150 to the general election, and Leon Sokol, \$1,150 to the primary and \$1,150 to the general election.

John B. Baldwin contributed \$2,300 on Marcy 7, 2007. Another individual, also named John B. Baldwin, contributed \$250 to the Committee on April 24, 2007. These are two separate individuals, and neither has contributed an excessive amount for the primary election.

The four contributions from Mary Ellen Duffy are actually from three separate individuals who reside at three separate addresses. The mother, Mary Ellen Duffy, contributed \$2,100 on January 18, 2007 and \$2,300 on June 30, 2007. The excessive portion of her contributions has been reattributed to the general election. Her daughter, also named Mary Ellen Duffy, contributed \$2,000 on June 29, 2007. Finally, her daughter-in-law, also named Mary Ellen Duffy, contributed \$2,100 on January 17, 2007.

Donald M. Flack and Donald F. Flack are not the same individuals, and thus neither has contributed an excessive amount for the primary election.

James Chumbley contributed \$2,300 to the primary election and \$200 to the general election, and therefore has not contributed an excessive amount.

Richard J. Codey made a single \$4,600 contribution to the Committee on June 5, 2007, and the excessive portion has been attributed to his spouse. Please note that the spelling of his name has been corrected (from Cody) on the amendment filed today.

Louise W. Coggins made the following contributions to the Committee: \$1,000 on March 2, 2007, \$1,000 on March 31, 2007, \$300 on June 30, 2007 and \$2,300 on June 30, 2007. The excessive portion of her primary contributions has been redesignated to the general election.

Stephen D. Coggins made two \$2,300 contributions to the Committee on June 30, 2007, and one of those contributions has been redesignated to the general election.

Troy Colbert made two contributions to the Committee: \$2,300 on February 2, 2007 and \$1,000 on June 7, 2007. The second contribution has been redesignated to the general election.

Erin Comerford made two contributions to the Committee: \$2,300 on March 27, 2007 and \$80 on May 22, 2007. The second contribution has been redesignated to the general election.

Stewart L. Cohen made two \$2,300 contributions to the Committee, one on March 9, 2007 and one on June 30, 2007. The Committee has combined his donor records and redesignated the second contribution to the general election.

II. Column B Figures

The Column B figures for the Summary and Detailed Summary Pages have been corrected and are reflected on the emended report filed today, September 21, 2007.

III. Cash Balance

The beginning cash balance has been corrected and is reflected on the amended report filed today, September 21, 2007.

IV. Election Cycle-to-Date Values

The Committee has reviewed the report and corrected any errors in the election cycle-to-date values. As a matter of policy, the Committee regularly analyzes contributor data for potential aggregation issues. All corrections are reflected in the amendment filed today, September 21, 2007.

V. Description of Disbursements

The Committee has reviewed the report for unacceptable purposes and replaced any such entries with more detailed and accurate descriptions. As with cycle-to-date values, the Committee regularly reviews disbursement records to ensure each is described with an acceptable purpose. All corrections are reflected in the amendment filed today, September 21, 2007.

VI. Staff Reimbursements

Disbursements described as airfare are not staff reimbursements but reimbursements to plane owners for the use of private aircraft for campaign travel. The Committee has described payments to all plane owners in this manner, but welcomes any additional suggestions from the Reports Analysis Division to more accurately describe the disbursements.

VII. Partnership Memos

The Committee has reviewed the report for disclosure errors for contributions from unincorporated partnerships, limited liability corporations and sole proprietorships and corrected any errors. All corrections are reflected in the amendment filed today, September 21, 2007.
