Dear Ms. Seay:

This is in response to the Federal Election Commission's analysis of the Madison Project, Inc.'s Amended July 2006 Quarterly FEC Disclosure Report and your request for additional information concerning that report.

1. The amended report disclosed additional disbursements on Line(s) 24 and 29 of the Detailed Summary Page totaling \$12,548. In the original filing, the committee reported on Line 29, expenses totaling \$1,421.02 and amended its report, reclassifying those expenditures to Line 24. At the time of filing, the committee had not been informed that a payment in the amount of \$12,548; dated 4/01/2006; and payable to HSP Direct had been issued from the fundraising escrow account. Upon learning of the disbursement, the committee disclosed the payment on Line 29. The fundraising expenses reported on Line 29 have been reclassified to Line 21(b).

2. The committee's Disclosure Report disclosed limited payments for administrative expenses. The Madison Project, Inc. has limited staff and their salaries are disclosed on Line 21(b); an office is not maintained by the committee; and the majority of the administrative functions were out-sourced to Potentials Business Services.
