All other members on this January 31 Year End 2013 report whose aggregate contributions have totaled \$200 or more in a calendar year, who have not notified CWALACPAC of their occupation and employer, have been sent a letter requesting said information with the following language:

"We are missing some very important information in our records for you in regards to your 2013 contributions! Federal election law requires us to use our best efforts to collect and report the name, mailing address, occupation and the name of employer of individuals whose total yearly contributions meet or exceed \$200 in a calendar year. Please help us comply with this requirement by responding to this letter, providing your occupation and employer in the section below. (Please note: if your occupation is "retired", "homemaker", "unemployed", or similar, please complete that section with "n/a". If you are self-employed, please list an occupation.)

"As we are required by law to report this information and have already filed a report without it, we would greatly appreciate your response as soon as you are able."

CWALACPAC uses its best efforts to comply with FEC employer/occupation reporting requirements by including a request for said information with every fundraising request sent to our members. The language is as follows:

"CWPAC is a Federal Political Action Committee - contributions are not tax deductible. Federal law requires the check signer's occupation and employer for yearly contributions totaling \$200 or more. Corporate and foreign checks are prohibited. Each individual may contribute up to \$5,000 per year to CWPAC and \$2,600 per candidate per election. (Primary, Special, General)"

Furthermore, if members contributing \$200 or more in a calendar year have not responded with the required information, we send a second letter, with no solicitation request, asking for the FEC required information. The language used in this letter is as follows:
