A principal campaign committee is an authorized committee designated by a candidate as the principal committee to raise contributions and make expenditures for his or her campaign for a federal office. 100.5(e)(1)

Please be advised that a Separate Segregated Fund is defined as a political committee established or financially supported by a corporation or labor organization. 114.1(a)(2)(iii)

If your committee is not a principal campaign committee, then an amended Statement of Organization should be submitted, which indicates the appropriate type of committee. If your committee is a Separate Segregated Fund, line 5(e) should be checked on the amended Statement of Organization. 11 CFR §102.2(a) (1)(i)

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an

enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
