Dear Mr. Booth:

On May 30, 2001 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your June 6, 2001 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

Your response states that "[these activities] were reported in the report covering the time period of July 1, 2000 through August 23, 2000 as regular expenses but were converted to joint activity for [this report]". The Commission has not received an amendment for the 12 Day Pre-Primary Report (7/1/00-8/23/00) disclosing these changes on the proper Schedules. Therefore, the discrepancy between Line(s) 18 Column A and Line(s) 21(a)(ii) Column A still exists.


The Commission recommends that you immediately transfer back to the non-federal account, the total excessive amount which was received by your federal account outside the 70-day time period. Although the Commission may take further legal action concerning this prohibited activity, your prompt action will be taken into consideration.

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by July 11, 2001.

Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions for time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
