Dear Ms. Davis:

On May 15, 2001, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your May 24, 2001 and June 20, 2001 responses are inadequate because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-Schedule(s) A and B of your report disclose activity that has not been included in the total for Line(s) 11(a)(i) and 17 of the Detailed Summary Page. In-kind contributions should not be reported as memo entries; rather, the value of in-kind contributions should be included in the total for the appropriate line on the Detailed Summary Page. Please amend your report to correct this discrepancy.

-You still need to provide a Schedule A to disclose the "last minute" contribution from Building & Construction Trades Dept. Federal PAC. Please amend your report to include this contribution.

-Commission Regulations require that a committee disclose the identification of all individuals who contribute in excess of \$200 in a calendar year. (11 CFR §104.3(a)(4)(i)) Identification for an individual is defined as the full name, mailing address, occupation and name of employer. (11 CFR §100.12) Your report discloses contributions from individuals for which the identification is not complete.
