Dear Mr. Connor:

On May 7, 2003, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your May 16, 2003 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i) of your report discloses a receipt(s) from "Payroll Contributions (unitemized)". Please be advised that federal regulations require the itemization of ail contributions from individuals/persons that aggregate greater than \$200 in the calendar year. Please clarify whether this figure includes any receipts that aggregate greater than \$200 from an individual/person. If this is the case, please smend your report(s) by itemizing the receipts on Schedule A. 11 CFR §104.3(a)(2) Otherwise, all contributions received that aggregate \$200 or less per individual for the calendar year should be reported on Line 11(a)(ii).

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by June 18, 2003. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions

of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
