Please check the election cycle dates and ensure that the beginning date for the election cycle is 11/5/08 and the ending date is 11/6/12. (2 U.S.C. § 434(b))

Please note you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may result in an enforcement action against the committee.
