Mr. Buckley:

This letter is in regard to your request for additional information dated February 11, 2011. The committee's response is as follows:

1a. The committee mistakenly listed three separate payments of \$14,902.66 to AHA Direct on 10/18/2010 as part of filed 24 hour notices. In fact, the committee actually paid AHA Direct a total of \$14,902.66 for all three independent expenditure direct mail pieces. The committee correctly listed these independent expenditures on its Post-General filing.

1b. The committee correctly reported paying Winning Connections \$69,093 for GOTV phone calls on its Post-General filing. The committee estimated that the cost of these calls to be \$76,000 on a 24 hour notice filed on 10/30/2010.

2. The committee listed an estimated payment to GRSC Consulting on a 24 hour notice filed 10/30/2010. This payment was waived by the vendor, with the cost of the independent expenditure being part of the other payments to GRSC Consulting. The committee correctly removed this payment from its Post-General filing.

3. The League of Conservation Voters Victory Fund (LCVVF) properly reported maintaining no debt on its Post-General report. LCVVF is an independent expenditure only committee established after the Speech Now vs. FEC decision, and may accept unlimited donations for the use of independent expenditures. The independent expenditures that were reported via memo entries by LCVVF in Schedule E were the result of in-kind contributions made by League of Conservation Voters, Inc. to LCVVF (and reported by LCVVF on Schedules A and B).
