Dear Mr. Feinman:

This letter is to inform you that as of December 18, 2002, the Commission has not received your response to our request for additional information, dated November 27, 2002. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. To ensure compliance with the provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act (the Act), please respond to this request (copy enclosed).

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by January 8, 2003. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended. This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-On Schedule A supporting Line 11(a)(i) of the Detailed Summary Page, your committee discloses apparent earmarked contributions received from "Steve Agin" and "Virginia Kapner" as MEMO entries. However, your committee has not provided a corresponding MEMO Schedule B supporting Line 23 of the Detailed Summary Page to itemize the actual disbursements to the federal candidates. Please amend your report to provide the omitted schedules or clarifying information.

Please note, your report discloses two apparent duplicate MEMO entries on Schedule A from Virginia Kapner earmarked for Chellie Pingree for US Senate.

A response or amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
