Dear Mr. Ryan:

This letter is in response to your April 22, 1998 request for additional information regarding the above referenced report.

Peace Political Action Committee (PeacePAC) is a small political committee affiliated with the Council for a Livable World, FEC Identification Number C00029165, and the two committees share office facilities. Peace PAC's share of administrative expenses such as rent, telephone and office expenses are paid by Peace PAC. These payments are reported correctly on Schedule B, Line 21b as operating expenditures. Income received from the Council for a Livable World is correctly reported on Schedule A, Line 12, as transfers from an affiliate committee.

Peace PAC pays its bills in a timely manner and rarely has a debt to list on Schedule D.

In-kind contributions, when received, are reported correctly on Schedule A as a receipt and Schedule B as a disbursement.


