
The purpose of this letter is to clarify questions in your letter dated July 26, 2001 (copy attached).

On the Detailed Summary Page lines 18 and 21(a)(ii) do not agree in the current period because the \$35,292.49 on line 18 includes transfers for expenditures that occurred during the reporting period October 19 to November 27, 2000.

On line 18, \$29,351.02 of the \$35,292.49 represents transfers for expenditures that occurred during the period November 3 to November 27, 2000. Therefore, the \$29,351.02 transfer from the non-federal to the federal fund on December 19, 2000, fulfills the requirement that all transfers be made no later than 60 days after a shared expenditure occurs.

On July 3, 2001 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your July 19, 2001 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.


-Your amendment now discloses \$35,292.49 in transfers from the non-federal account for joint activity; however, Line 21(a)(ii) discloses \$5,941.47 as the non-federal share of joint activity for the reporting period. While the non-federal account is permitted to transfer funds to the federal account for shared activity, transfers for shared activity must be made within a 70-day time period: no more than 10 days before or 60 days after the payment to the vendor. 11 C.F.R. §106.5(g)(2) and 106.6(c)(2) Please clarify the nature of the transfers-in from the non-federal account, and the reason for this discrepancy.

An adequate response must be received at the Commission by August 15, 2001. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions for time in**

which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
