Dear Ms. Lewis:

This letter is in response to your review of the 2005 September Monthly Report of HILLPAC C00363994 (the Committee).

You have requested that the Committee clarify a few of its expenditures made for Postage, and specifically whether they contained express advocacy or were made in support of a specific candidate. In the case noted, the Committee's expenditures benefited only the Committee, not a particular candidate, and contained no express advocacy. We believe that the explanation on the report -- that the expenditure was made for "Postage for HILLPAC's Solicitation" -- is self-explanatory. As per the Instructions for FEC3X and Related Schedules, the Committee reported these disbursements on line 21b as operating expenditures. The Committee intends to always report contributions to candidates, including express advocacy on their behalf, as instructed by FEC3X, on line 23, and independent expenditures, if any, as appropriate.

Additionally, please note that this is the same response the Committee made when additional information was requested by the Commission for similar expenditures on the May, June and July 2005 Monthly Reports. Please let us know if additional explanation, beyond this or that stated in the FEC3X Instructions, is needed when reporting these expenditures.

Thank you for your help and I hope this clarifies your question.
