

Memorandum to FEC in regards to your request for additional information dated December 22, 2006, for the October Monthly Report, please note the following. The September Monthly report has been amended, which updated the ending cash on hand for that report. The beginning cash on hand for the October Monthly report is now correct. Due to the amendment of the September Monthly report, the Column B totals for Lines 6, 11, 19 and 20 are now correct on the October Monthly report as well. A 24 Hour notice was filed for RBI Strategies in the amount of \$14,000 under Committee ID C90005786. The filing ID for that report is FEC-236934. While the RBI expenditure was inadvertently filed under the wrong League of Conservation Voters committee ID, it was in fact filed in a timely manner and was on the public record. The 24 Hour notice which was originally filed on September 29, 2006, with filing id FEC-240010 has been amended to correct the expenditure made to Customer Paradigm on September 28 in the amount of \$2,000. As reported on this Form 3X, that payment was in fact split as \$1,000 on behalf of Patsy Madrid and \$1,000 on behalf of Jon Tester. The payments referenced in your RFAI to American Express on behalf of Sestak and Casey were reported in error on 24-Hour reports. Those payments were in fact made by the League of Conservation Voters Inc, ID C90005786. The payments to Gold Communications on September 25 2006 which were originally reported on the 24-hour notices numbers 239792, 239795, 239796, and 239797 were subsequently voided, and the actual payments made on October 6, 2006, as part of a payment which was reported on the Pre-General report in the amount of \$44,359.40. That report will be amended to reflect the correct allocation of that payment. The October Monthly report has been amended to reflect that these payments were originally reported, and then voided. The payments on September 29, 2006, to Winning Connections have been corrected on the October Monthly report to show the correct allocation among candidates Sestak, Casey and Madrid, as originally reported on the 24 Hour Notice with filing ID FEC-240010.
