This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 2 items:


1. Your report discloses a payment(s) on Schedule B to "Discover Corporate Card" that has not been appropriately recorded on Schedule D. Debt payments must also be reflected on Schedule D in the "Payment this Period" field and not as a negative amount incurred. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy. 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(4)
2. Schedule D discloses \$554 in payment(s) this period to "Complete Campaigns"; however, there are \$500 in payments reflected on your disbursement schedules. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.

Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**
