Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 4 item(s):

1. Schedule A of your report discloses earmarked contributions totaling \$2,600, with no corresponding entries on Schedule B. Pursuant to 11 CFR §110.6(c)(1) (v), all earmarked contributions that have passed through a conduit's account must be itemized on the receipt (Schedule A) and disbursement (Schedule B) schedules, regardless of amount. All earmarked contributions that have been forwarded in the form of the contributor's check or written instrument must be itemized as memo entries on the receipt (Schedule A) and disbursement (Schedule B) schedules, regardless of the amount. Please amend your report to clarify these discrepancies.
2. Schedule A supporting Line 15 of your report discloses an offset to an operating expenditure(s) totaling \$4,444 from "Robert Raben," "Michael Paese," "Allen Huffman," "Kedrin Brachman," "Eduardo Garza," "Allen Hess," "Henry Cuellar," "Breanne Thomlison," "Lisa Van Varick," "Derron Parks," "Matthew Chiller," "Gwen Graham," and "Allison Binney"; however, your report(s) does not appear to disclose a disbursement to this entity. Please provide clarifying information regarding this activity and amend your report(s) if necessary. (11 CFR § 104.3(a) & (b))
3. Schedule B of your report discloses earmarked contributions totaling \$2,600, with no corresponding entries on Schedule A. Pursuant to 11 CFR §110.6(c),

all earmarked contributions, that have passed through a conduit's account, must be itemized on the receipt (Schedule A) and disbursement (Schedule B) schedules, regardless of the amount. All earmarked contributions that have been forwarded in the form of the contributor's check or written instrument must be itemized as memo entries on the receipt (Schedule A) and disbursement (Schedule B) schedules, regardless of the amount. Please identify the original contributors for the earmarked contributions disclosed on Schedule B.

4. On Schedule D of your previous report, you disclosed a debt owed to your committee from "Facebook, Inc." and "Google, Inc. Dept. 33654." This obligation, however, has been omitted from this report. Please amend your report to include this debt on Schedule D supporting Line 9 of the Summary Page. All debts and obligations must be disclosed until extinguished. (11 CFR §104.11)

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
