Dear Ms. Manning,

The Campaign for Working Families (FEC ID #C00325076) is in receipt of your letter dated June 26, 2002, referencing activity for the March and April reporting periods of 2001.

As an initial matter, the Committee did not file on a monthly schedule for 2001, but rather on a semi-annual schedule. Do you perhaps refer to the March and April reporting periods for 2002?

The Committee has addressed the issue of occupation and employer information in several previous responses, most recently on May 29, 2002. Once again, enclosed please find a sample committee solicitation. This solicitation, like all our solicitations, informs the donor that the committee is required to report the information, and asks that the donor provide it.

In addition, please find another sample of the letter we send to those donors whose contributions exceed \$200, but who do not provide us with their occupation and employer information when they send their contribution. We believe that this follow-up letter, which is sent out within thirty days of receipt of the contribution fulfills the "stand alone" provision in the regulations. A pre-addressed envelope (sample enclosed) is included with each follow-up request. All such information received is reported. In this manner, the committee believes that it is meeting the best efforts provisions outlined in your letters.

You raise the issue of disclosure of reattributions and redesignations in your letter for the activity on the March monthly report, but the Committee did not disclose any reattributions or redesignations on that report.
