Dear Mr. O'Connell:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. The review raised questions concerning certain information contained in the report(s). An itemization follows:

-Your report discloses two Schedule H1's for shared administrative federal and non-federal expenses. Please amend your report to include one Schedule H1 disclosing the proper allocation ratio for Administrative/Voter Drive expenses.

-Schedule H2 of your report discloses the Administration category of activity as being 100% federal. Please note that party committees must allocate any administrative expenses between the federal and nonfederal accounts in proportion to the ballot composition method derived from Schedule H1. 11 CFR §106.5. For future reporting, please be advised that any activity which is financed entirely by the federal account (including administrative expenses), should be reported on a Schedule B supporting Line 21(b). 11 CFR §106.5

-Please provide a Schedule H3 to support the entry on Line 12 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please note, all transfers received from a committee's non-federal account for joint activity should be reported on Line 18 of the Detailed Summary Page, as well as itemized on a Schedule H3 regardless of the amount transferred. 2 U.S.C. §434(b)(3)(D)


-Please amend your report by providing the address for each disbursement itemized on Schedule(s) H4 supporting Line(s) 21(a).

-Your report disclosed certain categories of financial activity that have been reflected on the wrong lines of the Detailed Summary Page. Operating expenses should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule(s) B, supporting Line 21(b) of the Detailed Summary Page. Please refer to the instructions contained on the forms to determine the proper categorization when preparing your next filing.

-For your information, all contributions received that aggregate \$200 or less per individual for the calendar year should be reported on Line 11(a)(ii). Contributions received aggregating over \$200 per individual for the calendar year should be reported on Line 11(a)(i) and itemized on Schedule A.

A response or an amendment to your original report(s) correcting the above problem(s) should be filed with the Federal Election Commission within fifteen (15) days of the date of this letter. Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designation and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
