The DCCC did not make an excessive coordinated expenditure. The Committee received a delegation of the Minnesota Democratic Party's 441a(d) limit that more than covered the amount of the expenditure in excess of \$35,910. No corrective action is required. _

We have amended Schedule F for the above referenced report to include the identification of the designating committee, the payee's name and address, the purpose of the expenditure, the identification of the candidate supported, the office sought, state and district, the date and amount of the payment and the aggregate general election expenditure total for each candidate supported. □

We have also amended Schedule H2 for the above referenced report to provide a unique identifying code for all fundraising events. □
