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This responds to your request for additional information dated October 18, 2011.

(1) Consistent with 11 CFR 104.5(f), the Committee has procedures in place for reporting within 48 hours, late contributions of \$1,000 or more received between two and twenty days before an election. The Committee has filed 48-hour reports to disclose two of the contributions at issue (Christopher Townsend received on June 24, 2011 and Josh Pertula received on July 4, 2011). The contribution from Ann Barker received on June 28, 2011 was disclosed on a 48-hour report on June 29, 2011. Contributions from IATSE-PAC, Tri-State Maxed Out Women inc. PAC and Writers Guild of America West PAC were received on July 8, 2011 and disclosed on a 48-hour report on July 9, 2011.

(2) The contributions from Henry Danpour, John Danpour, Sauli Danpour, Vincent Roberti and Daphna Ziman were disclosed on 48-hour reports filed on July 8, 2011 at 16:39 and July 8, 2011 at 23:07. These contributions at issue are not duplicate contributions. Rather, the 48-hour report filed on July 8, 2011 at 23:07 was amending the report filed on July 8, 2011 at 16:39.

(3) The amended 30 Day Post-Runoff Report disclosed a decrease in the amount of debts from those disclosed on the original 30 Day Post-Runoff Report. Due to a software error, payments made during the reporting period were disclosed on Schedule B of the original 30-Day Post-Runoff Report. However, the payments were not reflected on Schedule D of the same report to show that the debt was paid. The Committee filed an amendment on August 19, 2011 to correct the error.
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
