On April 29, 2003 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your May 5, 2003 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-The Commission is in receipt of your letter, dated 5/5/03, detailing the committee's "best efforts" procedures. Please note, your follow-up, stand alone effort must take place no later than 30 days after the receipt of the contribution and contain no new solicitations. Please clarify the text of your stand alone effort and when your committee sends the follow-up request listed as part of your "best efforts" procedures.



An adequate response must be received at the Commission by June 11, 2003. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions for time in

which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.
