Dear Ms. Spidel:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **An adequate response must be received at the Commission by the response date noted above.** An itemization of the information needed follows:

-The beginning cash balance of this report should equal the ending balance of your 2004 July Quarterly Report. Please clarify this discrepancy and amend any subsequent report(s) that may be affected by this correction.

-The totals listed on Lines 6(c), 7, 11(a)(iii), 11(d), 13, 19, 20, 21(b), 21(c), 31, and 32, Column B of the Summary and Detailed Summary Page(s) appear to be incorrect. Please be advised that you should add the "Calendar Year-to-Date" total from your previous report to the current "Total This Period" figure from Column A to derive the correct Column B totals. Please amend your report and any subsequent reports that may be affected by this correction.

-Your previous filing, the 2004 July Quarterly Report, disclosed a \$2,000 loan from Joe Liberteili and a \$1,000 loan from Pam Paul. This report, however, does not include a Schedule C to disclose the status of the loan(s), nor are there any loan repayments on Schedule B. Please provide a Schedule C to show the status of the loan(s) and/or a Schedule B to show loan repayments. Loans must be continuously reported until they are repaid. 11 CFR §104.3(d)


-Your report discloses a loan on Schedule H4 to "PDA," which has not been recorded on Schedule C. Loans made by your committee must be reflected on Schedule C as well as on Schedule B supporting Line 27 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy. 2 U.S.C. 434(b)(4)(H)(ii)

-Schedule H4 of your report discloses activity which is 100% federal. For future reporting, please be advised that any activity which is financed entirely by the federal account (including administrative expenses), should be reported on Schedule B supporting Line 21(b). 11 CFR §§106.6 and 106.7

Unlike previous election cycles, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered. Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action.

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
