Regarding Schedule B expenditure for Reimbursement Earmark for Auction Items : This expenditure was a reimbursement to the connected organization (Safari Club International) for expenses paid for SCI-PAC fundraising which exceeded the allowable 1/3 Rule. This activity which occurred in January of 2008 was neither express advocacy nor public communication, but rather fundraising expenses (raffle prizes, auction items, etc.). The reimbursement payment to the connected organization was made after the event no advance payments were made.
