On April 9, 1997 you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.


Your May 1, 1997 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-The Commission acknowledges the \$6,000 in transfers to your Non-Federal Account of the misdeposited contributions from ATLA-PAC and the Friends of Blanche. You still need to clarify if the contributions received from the Adams & Refe Law Firm, AR Automobile Dealers Assoc. PAC (originally reported as Dealers Interested in Government) and Clark County Democratic Committee are composed of permissible funds. In addition, there was no supporting documentation accompanying your amendment for Clark County Democratic Committee.

If this information is not received by the Commission within fifteen (15) days from the date of this notice, the Commission may choose to initiate audit or legal enforcement action.
