Dear Mr. Ryan,

The Independent Action Political Action Committee uses "best efforts" to obtain and report required contributor information. We understand the new regulations in this area, including the specific request for contributor information which must be clear and conspicuous on the response card for each solicitation. The request informs the contributor that the reporting of such information is required by law.

For each >\$200 contributor, we either (1) report the occupation and employer on Schedule A, or (2) if this information is not known, we mail a request for information without solicitation within 30 days of receipt of the contribution. Amended reports include the additional information received from contributors.

The amended Mid-Year Report (enclosed) has been corrected with respect to the total of itemized contributions for line 11(a)(i).

An amended Year End Report is near completion and will be submitted to you within 5 days.
