Dear Treasurer:

This letter is prompted by the Commission's preliminary review of the report(s) referenced above. This notice requests information essential to full public disclosure of your federal election campaign finances. **Failure to adequately respond by the response date noted above could result in an audit or enforcement action.** Additional information is needed for the following 4 item(s):

1. Your report discloses \$5,863.79 from "United States Treasury" in Offsets to Operating Expenditures on Line 15 of the Detailed Summary Page. Please be advised that if there are not corresponding expenditures for these entries, it may constitute an excessive or prohibited contribution. Please amend your report or provide an explanation for this apparent discrepancy. (2 U.S.C 434(b) & 11 CFR § 104.3(a) and (b))
2. On Schedule H2, you disclose the ratio for "Indiana Democratic Editorial Associati" to be the same as previously reported; however, it appears that this activity/event was not previously reported. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy. (11 CFR §§104.10 and 104.17)
3. On Schedule H2 of your report you disclose the ratios for both "Indiana Democratic Editorial Associati" and "State Jefferson Jackson Dinner" to be 75% Federal and 25% Non-Federal. However, your Schedule H4 calculations reflect the ratios to be 36% Federal and 64% Non-Federal. Please amend your report to clarify this discrepancy.

Please note that if your non federal account has overpaid your federal account because of this miscalculation, it will be necessary to immediately transfer these funds back to the non federal account. While the Commission may take

further legal action concerning any impermissible overpayments by the non federal account, your prompt action will be taken into consideration. (11 CFR §§104.10 and 104.17)

4. Your report disclosed a category of financial activity that has been reflected on the wrong line of the Detailed Summary Page. Contributions from federal candidates should be properly disclosed on a separate Schedule A, supporting Line 11(c) of the Detailed Summary Page. Please refer to the instructions for each line when determining the proper categorization(s) for your next filing. (2 U.S.C § 434(b) and FORM 3X Instructions)

**Please note, you will not receive an additional notice from the Commission on this matter.** Adequate responses must be received by the Commission on or before the due date noted above to be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response submitted by your committee will be placed on the public record and will be considered by the Commission prior to taking enforcement action. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.**

Electronic filers must file amendments (to include statements, designations and reports) in an electronic format and must submit an amended report in its entirety, rather than just those portions of the report that are being amended.
