Dear Ms. Kang:

This letter is in response to your request for additional information regarding the above-mentioned report. An itemization of the questions raised follows:

There is a discrepancy between Line 18 Column A and Line 21 because the transfers made from our non-federal account during this reporting period includes transfers that relate to joint activity expenditures from the previous reporting period. Our transfers were made within the 70-day time period. No impermissible transfers were made, no further disclosure is needed.

Regarding our joint fundraising activity, as required we itemized the contribution of each contributor that exceeded the \$200 threshold and provided the amount of unitemized contributions received. - See page 36 of 294. The entry listing the unitemized contributions received references "unitemized receipts" from joint fundraiser. There is a discrepancy between the amount itemized vs. unitemized because the majority of the contributions did not exceed the threshold even when aggregated. No further disclosure is needed.

Regarding the contribution from the partnership Stokes, Lazarus & Carmichael; as required, our original report discloses the name of the contributing partner, Mr. Wayne Lazarus, on Schedule A line 11(a)(i) page 21 of 294. No further disclosure is needed.
