On April 9, 2003, you were notified that a review of the above-referenced report(s) raised questions as to specific contributions and/or expenditures, and the reporting of certain information required by the Federal Election Campaign Act.

Your April 21, 2003 response is incomplete because you have not provided all the requested information. For this response to be considered adequate, the following information is still required.

-You state in your response that there were no transfers made during this reporting period. However, your Schedule H3 indicates transfers from your state account in the following amounts: \$4000, \$4100, \$4000 and \$7500. Please amend your report to show the correct breakdown for all transfers received from your state account.

-You state in your response that you are mailing copies of checks from the California Republican Party. The Commission has not yet received these copies.


An adequate response must be received at the Commission by May 21, 2003. Adequate responses received on or before this date will be taken into consideration in determining whether audit action will be initiated. **Requests for extensions of time in which to respond will not be considered.** Failure to provide an adequate response by this date may result in an audit of the committee. Failure to comply with the provisions of the Act may also result in an enforcement action against the committee. Any response
